- Administering and supporting implementations

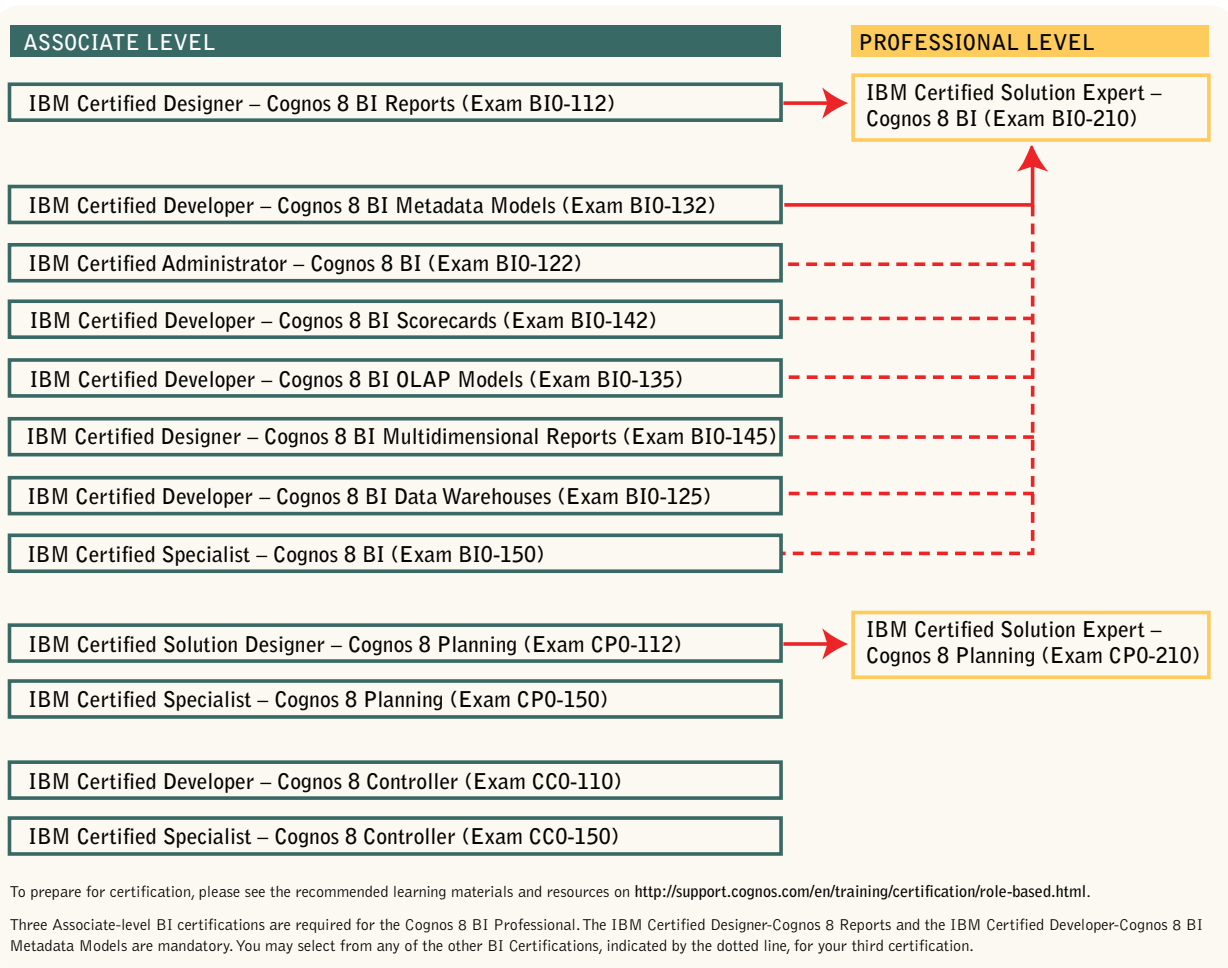
IBM Professional-level Certification
